TOWN BOARD REPORTS - Clerk reported on successful election held on April 7, 2020 despite the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) and distributed information on tabulator machine. Board reported on various matters handled during the month, provided status reports on individual projects and matters for May agenda. Peterik reported that Richard Neuser has retired - Bill Jindra will now be doing both plumbing and electrical inspections, presented communication regarding Phragmites control program, and cemetery issues.

Annual Meeting – Meeting/Adjournment – Clerk presented information on the recently enacted 2019 Wisconsin Act 185 and the current public health emergency. Discussion. **Motion by Rabitz, second by Argall, to postpone the annual town meeting to a future date. All voting aye, motion carried.** When a date has been set, appropriate notices will be posted to inform the public.
