Treasurer's report accepted on motion by Peterik, second by Argall. All voting aye, motion carried.

Next meeting set for May 3, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. on motion by Rabitz, second by Argall. All voting aye, motion carried.

Motion by Rabitz, second by Argall, to adopt agenda in any order. All voting aye, motion carried.

Public Comment – Reindl inquired about turnaround on Novy Road. Belinski inquired about a 5 year contract with town for snowplowing (matter will be placed on May agenda).

Building, Zoning & Culvert Permits – Building permits were issued to: Kyle Kudick for new residence located at 16222 CTH B, Mishicot and Neil Behnke for a storage shed at 16633 Nachtwey Road, Maribel.

Motion by Argall, second by Rabitz, to grant Ron Lese, a culvert permit for an 18" x 30" culvert with endwalls for property located at 17233 Harpt Lake Road. All voting aye, motion carried.

Town Board Reports – Argall reported on Manitowoc County Unit meeting attendance. Rabitz reported on various calls received during the month. Clerk reported on April 6, 2021 election, approval of Ryan Skabroud conditional use permit review, naming of Old Y bridge and correspondence from county surveyor regarding government corners. Peterik reported on heavy weight limits taken off by county today and various calls received during the month.

Ambulance/Recycling/County Representative – Wegner mentioned March 26, 2021 fish boil for ambulance service was a success and recycling center is doing well. Falkowski reported county had approximately a \$1,000,000.00 surplus and provided explanations regarding Manitowoc County Hazmat and .05% county sales tax.

Mishicot Sportsmen Club – Rent Agreement – Tony Heyroth spoke on behalf of the club and stated that they would like to renew their agreement for seven years. The club provides many sponsorships to children for various programs and activities. Discussion. **Motion by Peterik, second by Rabitz, to sit down with Mishicot Sportsmans Club representatives to go over terms of lease and renewal of same. All voting aye, motion carried.**

Old CC – Road Damage/Weight Limits – Peterik received many complaints of heavy trucks running on road.

Tisch Mills Fire Department – Motion by Rabitz, second by Argall, to approve Tisch Mills Fire Department Contract for period April 15, 2021 to April 14, 2022. All voting aye, motion carried.

Road Projects – No report.

Utility Permit – Motion to approve Wisconsin Public Service Utility Permit for work along Tapawingo and Becker Roads. All voting aye, motion carried. Project will replace overhead service with underground service.

Jambo Creek Cemetery – map correction – Discussion on cemetery markings and needed corrections to map and plots sold. Rabitz will contact Zeitler and report at May meeting.

Annual Meeting/Report – Clerk distributed report and gave reminder of meeting.

American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 – update – Clerk reported town will receive \$130,878.09 through the plan. Board will wait for clarification on allowable use of funds.

Road Inspection & Budget Dates – Road inspection date will be Saturday, May 1, 2021 starting at 8:00 a.m. and a road budget date will be scheduled at May 3, 2021 town board meeting.

East Tuma Lake Road TRIP Project – Board decided to stop project planning at this time and not utilize TRIP funds.

Liquor & Operator Licenses – Motion by Rabitz, second by Argall, to approve Operator’s License for Katrina Mae Keil. All voting aye, motion carried.
