Meeting called to order at 6:30 p.m. Peterik, Rabitz, Argall and Herman present. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Minutes of February 1 and 15, 2021 read and accepted on motion by Rabitz, second by Argall All voting aye, motion carried.

Next meeting set for April 5, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. on motion by Rabitz, second by Argall. All voting aye, motion carried.

Motion by Argall, second by Rabitz, to adopt agenda in any order. All voting aye, motion carried.

CliftonLarsonAllen Audit Report Presentation – Amber Drewieske of CLA presented the 2020 audit report stating that the town is in good financial position. She recommends classifying future county bridge aid reimbursements as designated bridge funds for future expenditures and that cash from recycling center continues to be handled with proper practices and verifications in place.

Building, Zoning & Culvert Permits – Ryan Skabroud conditional use permit to operate a part-time firearm manufacturing, firearm and outdoor product sales and repair business is scheduled for two year review by Manitowoc County Board of Adjustment in March. The board has not received any complaints regarding this matter and clerk will inform county of same.

Motion by Rabitz, second by Argall, to grant Adam Mills, 17120 Old CC, Maribel, WI a building permit for a 30' x 50' storage shed. All voting aye, motion carried.

Town Board Reports – Argall reported picking up car parts on Princ Road, placing barricades on Old CC road damage area, and a sign on Melnik Road needs a new post (Peterik will contact county). Rabitz looked at culverts on Rainbow and Tuma Lake Road. Clerk presented final year-end financial reports and road expense reports; noted that board of review training will take place this year and materials will be ordered. Report on ground water monitoring at landfill was received and all is good. Peterik reported on calls regarding road heaves and road restrictions are being placed on various roads by Manitowoc County.

Ambulance/Recycling/County Representative – Wegner mentioned March 26, 2021 fish boil for ambulance service.

Snowplowing – No complaints received.

Twin Bridge Road Culverts – Nothing to report at this time.

Public Input – Kronforst inquired about plaque renaming Old Y Bridge for Frank Hlinak and past motion regarding same. Clerk will do research and report back to board.

Old CC – Road Damage/Weight Limits – Peterik received calls on road damage done by Ryan Collins on February 24, 2021. Peterik spoke to Collins who is in agreement to pay for damages. Peterik contacted Manitowoc County and they would complete repairs with cold mix. Rabitz questioned material to be used and timing of repair work. Discussion. **Motion by Argall, second by Peterik, for county to repair damaged portions on Old CC and we will bill contractor for cost. All voting aye, motion carried.** Weight limits on Old CC were discussed as calls are being received by Peterik regarding loaded trucks. Peterik suggests lowering weight limit to 10 ton to save road. Discussion and matter will be placed on agenda next month.

East Tuma Lake Road TRIP Project – Rabitz stated to have project done and paved by June 22, 2021 should not be a problem. He has been in contact with Ayres. Matter will be placed on April agenda along with culvert bid matter for end of road. Contract will be prepared by Ayres and given to clerk for chairman’s signature.

Town of Gibson Comprehensive Plan – update/appointments – Argall reported on group he has assembled and procedure for appointments. Matter will be on May agenda.

Liquor & Operator Licenses – None.
